- Interacting with shelter animals*

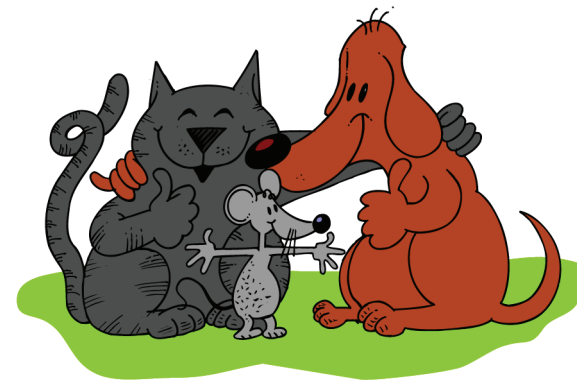
*Please note:
