Key Accomplishments for the Potter League August 2010 - July 2011

August

A seven page, feature article on the Potter League's Gold LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) certified green building appears in the 2011 annual publication of *Natural Dog*, a national magazine.



September

The Potter League hosts an Adoption Options Seminar sponsored by Petco Foundation and PetFinders.com. Over 100 staff members from shelters in the New England and New York area attend an all day workshop with presentations on shelter medicine, animal behavior and increasing adoptions.

October

Brian Kilcommons, renowned author and master dog-trainer, gives a lecture and hands-on demonstration to 110 attendees in our Behavior and Training Center. The Potter League's green building is one of the stops on the Rhode Island Green Building Association's annual open house tour.

November

All dogs and cats at the Potter League receive FRONTLINE or HEARTGARD during their shelter stay and adopters receive a keepsake New Pet Starter Kit courtesy of Merial. The Potter League is one of ten shelters in the country selected to participate in this important animal-care pilot program.



December

The Potter League hosts a workshop for the Rhode Island Veterinary Medical Association to distribute free oxygen masks for pets to local fire and rescue departments. Training to use the masks is also provided. Critter Glitter jewelry sale raises critical funds to help close the capital campaign – thanks, once again, to the generosity of Sequin.

January

Honoring Their Trust, the capital campaign for the Potter League's new building, comes to a conclusion having successfully exceeded its \$7.8 million goal.

February

The Potter League Board of Directors approves a five year Strategic Plan for the organization which was formulated by the Strategic Planning Committee over the previous six months. Over 500 guests attend the 38th annual Have a Heart Cocktail Party & Auction and help raise a record \$97,000. The Behavior Department begins holding a monthly Feline Forum to help cat owners with their pets' behavior problems.

March

Our Fetching Friends program has its first collaboration with Cloud Nine Rescue Flights to transport and fly in 22 dogs from Mitchell County Animal Rescue in Spruce Pines, NC to the state airport in Middletown. Cloud Nine makes two additional flights during this fiscal year to deliver a total of 70 dogs and puppies to the Potter League – where lives are saved.

April

Potter League comes to the aid of 29 black cats when the sanctuary where they were residing is shut down. The founder of the sanctuary had become overwhelmed with the cost of caring for the animals.



May

Be Kind to Animals Week is celebrated in a colorful way with a state-wide poster contest featuring talented young artists from various schools. The League's training department graduates a fabulous group of star pupils from our Puppy Honors class.

June

Potter League is the focus of another feature article in a national animal publication, this time it is the June edition of *Cat Fancy*. The sun shines on our 22nd annual Heart and Sole Walk for the Animals as 500 participants and their dogs spend a great day together raising money for less fortunate animals.

July

Miramar, a beautiful Bellevue Avenue estate, is the setting for our third annual Tea for Tails which has become a 'must attend' summer party. Highlights include a special recognition for Ruth Buchanan in whose honor the Behavior & Training Room was recently named and the raising of lifesaving donations for the Potter League's Fetching Friends program.

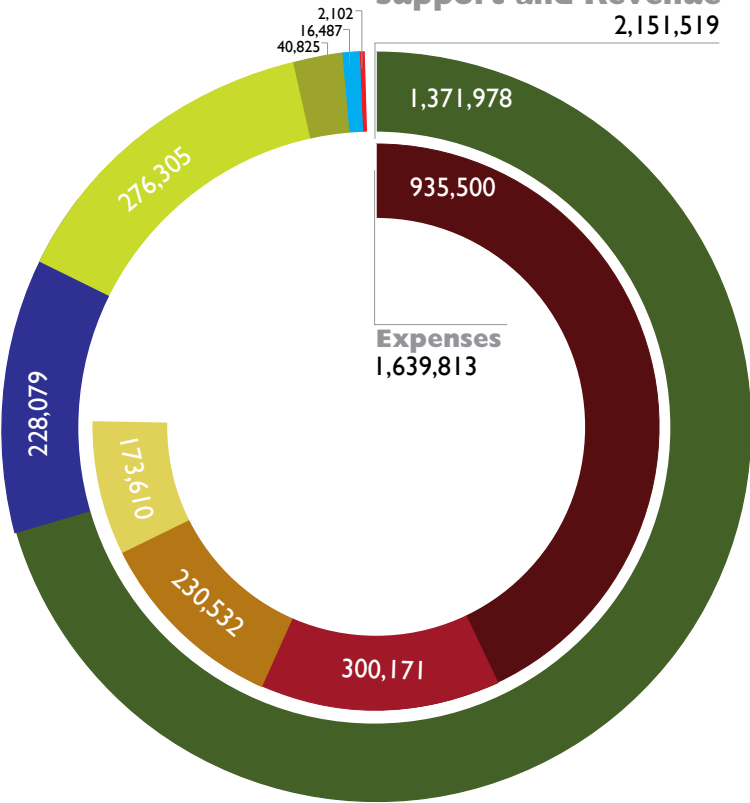

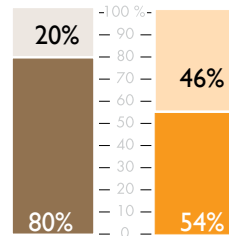

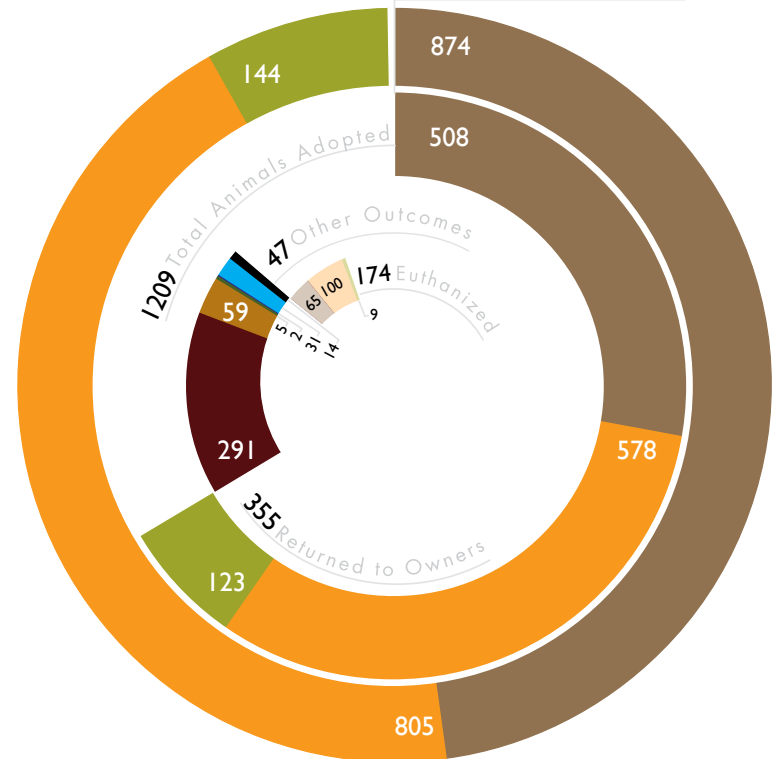

Reaching Out for the Animals

Raising Awareness

To promote adoptions, adoptable animals were featured in The Newport Daily News' Pet of the Week and Love-a-Pet advertisements. Ask Bootsie, a weekly pet advice column, was published in The Newport Daily News and a Pet Feature was published in The Women's Journal bi-monthly. PSA's on WPRI 12 FOX Providence promoted our Walk for the Animals and Have a Heart Party. The Potter League was a monthly regular on a radio show hosted by Art Beluti on WADK. Fans regularly followed our Facebook page and supporters visited our website for the latest Potter League news and to view adoptable animals.

Pet Visitation Program

Through our Animal Assisted Activity program, volunteers and their pets brought joy to the physically and mentally challenged, the elderly, and residents of long term care facilities and hospitals in our community.

Pet Loss Support

In recognizing the integral role pets play in our lives, the Potter League offered monthly support sessions for those grieving the loss of a beloved pet.

Pet Safe

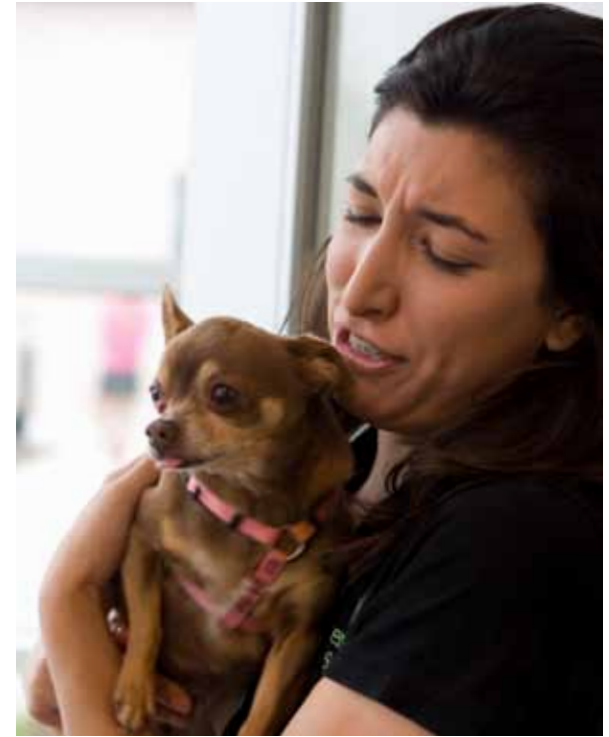
The Potter League provided temporary housing for pets during their owners' challenging times. The program provided short term housing to the elderly who needed hospitalization and had no one to care for their animals, to victims of domestic violence who were fleeing from a dangerous environment, and those experiencing a disaster such as a fire or flood.

Potter Pet University

Evening lectures for adults covered a range of topics from caring for cats and rabbits to dealing with separation anxiety in dogs.

Off-Site Pet Adoptions

Newport Animal Hospital, Newport Animal Clinic and Portsmouth Veterinary Clinic hosted Potter League cats for adoption at their facilities. Every Saturday was adoption day at Petco with visits by Potter League volunteers and adoptable pets.

Educating Future Generations

The Potter League has a deep commitment to securing a better future for animals. Our humane education programs teach younger generations about the responsibilities of caring for companion animals and the vital role animals play in our world. These successful programs foster compassion and encourage a respect for all living things.

This year, over 3,000 children benefited from 406 humane education presentations and sessions in local schools. Program offerings ran the gamut from a pet overpopulation lesson as part of the seven lesson curriculum for third graders to an endangered species lesson taught during the five lesson curriculum for seventh graders. A variety of children from preschoolers to teen clubs received presentations on pet care and safety around animals. *Coping with Coyotes* educated students on how to stay safe around wildlife.



Children visited the Alletta Morris Education Center at the Potter League to participate in shelter tours to learn about the role of an animal shelter, earn a Girl Scout patch on pet care, improve their reading skills by sharing a favorite animal book with a doggy partner, attend a birthday party with a humane theme, and attend camp sessions with interactive, hands-on animal activities.

Caring for our Animal Companions

Adoption Readiness

All animals in our facility are behaviorally and medically evaluated before entering the adoption program. Animals receive medical examinations, age-appropriate vaccinations and preventative treatments, sterilization surgeries as well as other medical procedures when needed. Behavior assessments identify problem behaviors and allow for training or socialization activities needed to enhance the animals' chances for adoption.

Pet Adoption

The Potter League believes in new beginnings. We believe in a fresh start for each adoptable animal in our program. With ongoing support and by carefully matching our homeless animals with responsible, caring adopters, the Potter League works to ensure that these new relationships will last. There is no time limit for how long an adoptable animal can stay in our shelter.

Reuniting Families

Not all animals entering our facility are homeless. Some are lost, frightened cats and dogs who can't find their way home. The Potter League works diligently to reunite lost pets with their loving families. Our staff maintains an extensive

database of lost and found pets. A listing of all the stray animals in our building can be found on our website. To increase our chances of returning pets home safely, the Potter League issues free Potter Pet Identification Tags.

Fetching Friends

As more of our constituents opt to rescue homeless dogs and cats, the Potter League's Fetching Friends is truly a life saving program. We transport animals from shelters in North Carolina, Pennsylvania and other areas which have overwhelming pet overpopulation problems. We also help more local shelters and rescue organizations which become overcrowded.

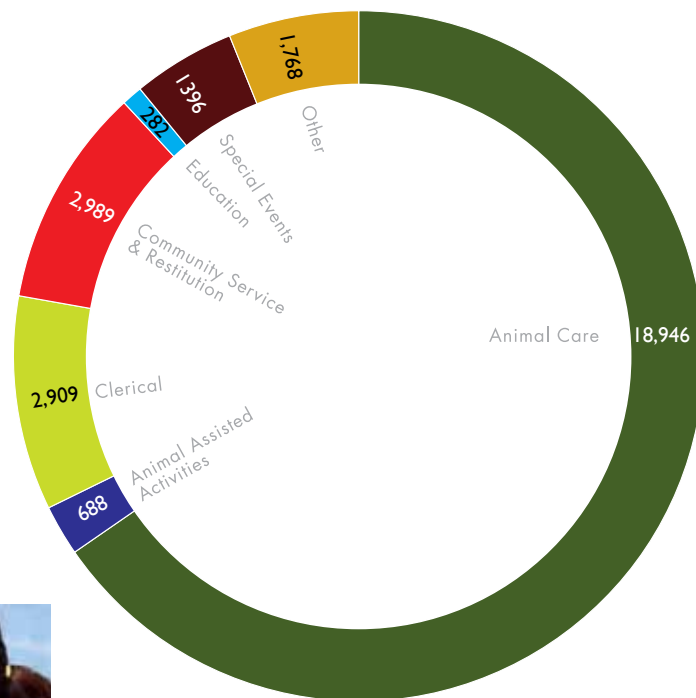
Lending a Hand

Potter League volunteers are crucial to our every day operations. Their contribution of time and talent assists us in providing the highest quality of care to our animals and the best customer service to our constituents. Over 530 new volunteers were orientated to our organization this year joining the 647 volunteers who already serve. In 2011, these volunteers donated 28,978 hours of service.

Among the jobs volunteers perform are making sure the animal rooms are clean and comfortable, socializing our cats and small critters, walking and training the dogs, and providing foster care. Front desk volunteers and greeters assist visitors and promote animals for adoption.

Volunteers visit nursing homes with Potter Pets, represent the League at community events, help organize and run our special events, mentor students and teach humane education classes, photograph the animals, mow our field, bring animals to veterinary offices for surgeries, and much, much more.

All of our volunteers are held in the highest of esteem. At the 2011 volunteer dinner, Carol Chabot was recognized as Volunteer of the Year and Andrew Panaggio received the Lori Owens Award. Mary and Alisha January, Heather Downs, Sylvia Magleby, Mickie Musselman, Dr. Mark Stamoulis, Blair Andrade, Darla Weisen, Jerome Weisen, Kathleen Hart, Dianna O'Dell, Jackie Toracinta and Kathleen Sousa were recognized throughout the year as Volunteers of the Month.

Building Better Relationships

The Potter League is committed to keeping people and animals together by helping them overcome challenging behavior problems and by strengthening the human-animal bond. Our Behavior and Training Department is a community resource which assists in furthering these goals.

Behavior & Training Center

In our indoor 1,600 square foot facility, we offer a variety of classes and enrichment activities designed for dogs of all ages, sizes and training levels. Offerings range from structured six week courses to less formal, drop-in playgroups. Specialty classes target particular problem behaviors or provide practice sessions to improve handling skills.

HeadStart

This life-saving program involves intense training for select shelter dogs with skilled volunteers and our expert staff. Consistent training plans for individual dogs provide them with basic obedience skills and increased socialization to help ensure a successful adoption.

Support

Adopters receive advice and support through our weekly dog adopter classes. Cat adopters can attend our monthly Feline Forum to discuss cat issues. The Potter League also offers a free Behavior Helpline which is manned by behavior department staff to offer advice on common dog and cat behavior problems.
